In 2022-2023 we will:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continue to heavily subsidise all trips and visits outside of school in order to ensure that low income does not impact on a child's access to the experiences we offer• Extend the offer of trips and visits across the school year, for all year groups - this will include opportunities for more children to have valuable experiences such as a trip to the theatre to see a pantomime• Fully fund any visitors in to school in order to enhance our curriculum offer• Organise a one-night residential experience for children in Year 4 in partnership with West View Project• Organise a new residential for the children in Year 5 which is more adventurous in nature• Organise a city break residential to Edinburgh for the children in Year 6• Children in Years 4, 5 and 6 will take part in the National Navigation Award programme and opportunities will be planned each year for them to achieve the next stage of the award• Provide opportunities for staff to be trained in Beach Schools and Forest Schools
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
