OVERVIEW



Below are the English texts used throughout our entire school. These books are used for writing lessons from Year 1 to Year 6. Additionally, in Years 3 to 6, these books are used in our whole-class reading sessions.

Early Years follow a 'book a fortnight' schedule where themed books are shared during reading for pleasure time and throughout the environment. Reception also use Greg Bottrill's 'Drawing Club' as a vehicle for teaching writing – separate books are used in these sessions.

A whole school poetry spine is followed each half term in school ensuring a full collection of poems is covered in Years 1 to 6.

Non- fiction texts are indicated by ***Italic and bold*** writing in the following document

During transition weeks in school, we have one theme across the whole school which changes annually. We use books as a basis for all teaching and learning during these weeks e.g. a focus on Inspirational People using the 'Little People, Big Dreams' books or learning about different places and cultures using the book 'This is our world'.



Within Pre-Nursery, the children follow a ‘book a fortnight’. These books are used with a reading focus.

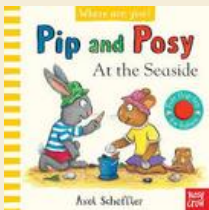
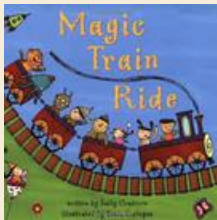
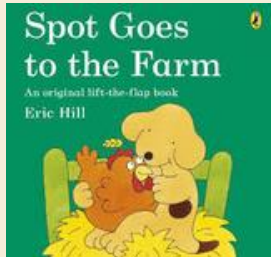
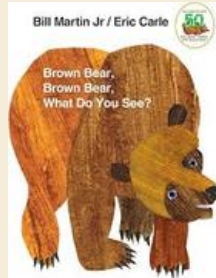
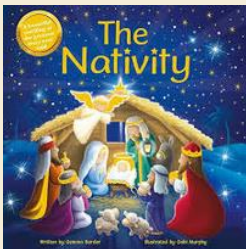
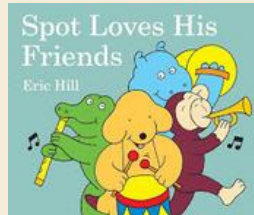
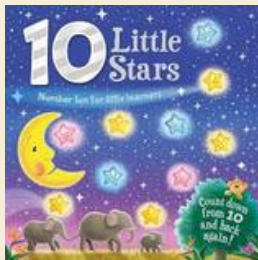
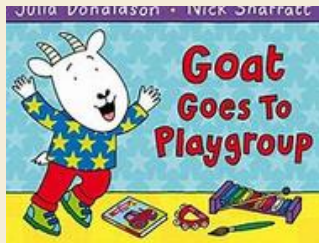
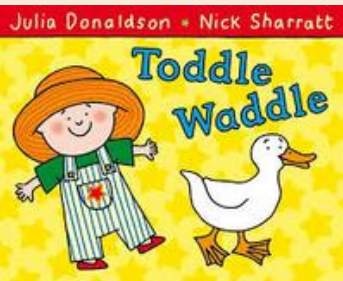
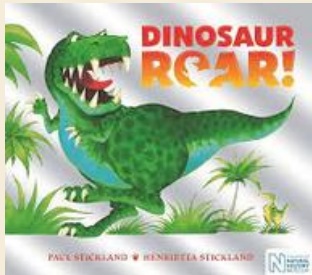
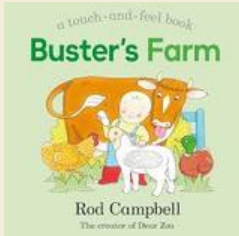
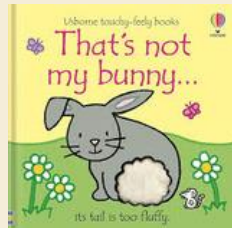
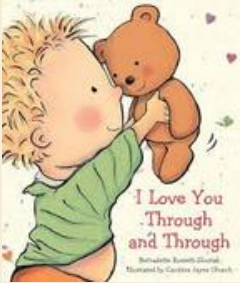
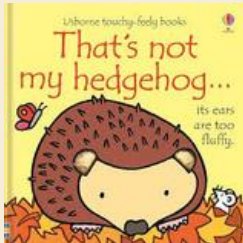
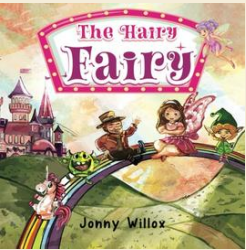
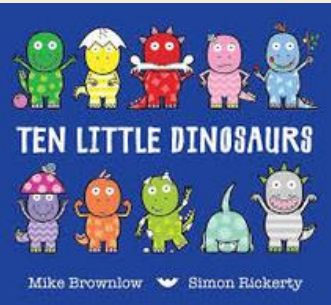
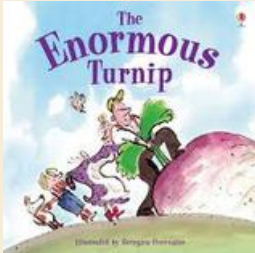
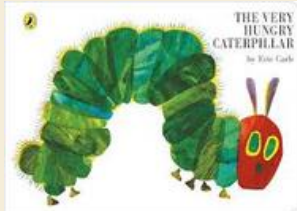
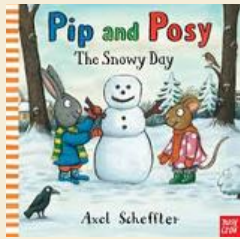
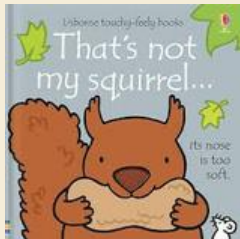
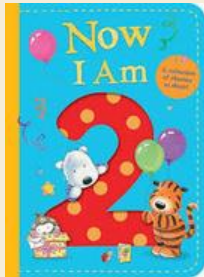
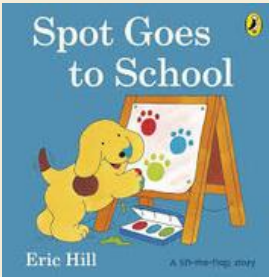

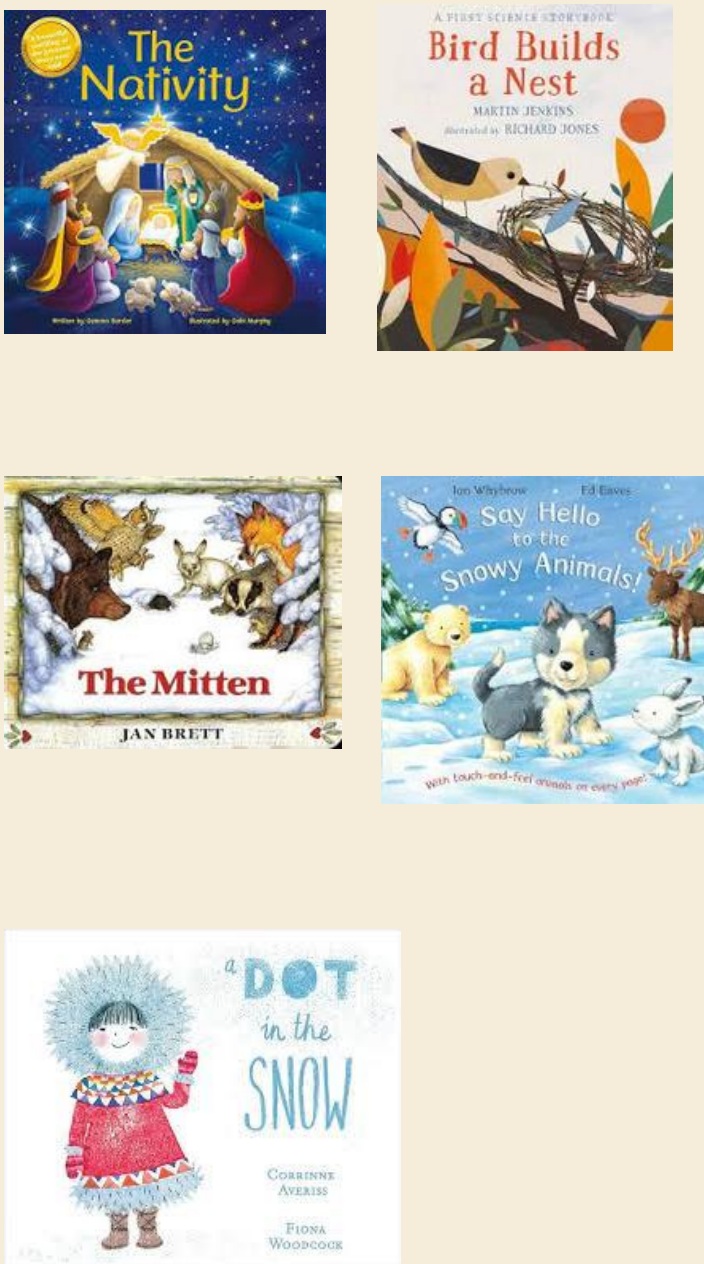
NURSERY
