

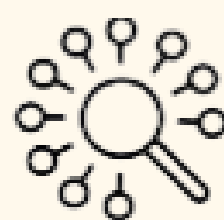


Map work to consolidate learning on geographical skills, for example labelling countries, identifying physical features or creating a sketch map of areas studied.

Exit tickets to check understanding of geographical concepts or could be used at the end of a lesson to recap from a previous topic such as map skills, climate zones or physical features.



Recap and review used at the beginning of the lesson to check prior knowledge of a previous or current geography topic such as countries, continents or geographical processes.



Quiz - could be created on Kahoot, Blooket or Seesaw for example.

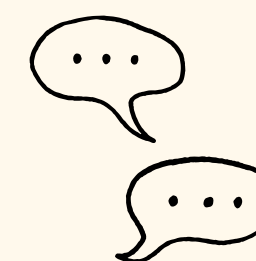


Geography Assessment Menu

Photo analysis - provide photographs of different locations, geographical features, or landscapes and children identify, describe, and explain what they can see using geographical vocabulary and knowledge from topics studied.



Discussion - give a group a question, image, map or key geographical term to discuss what they know and can remember about it.



Concept mapping - at the end of a topic give the children the geographical theme that they have just covered (e.g. rivers, mountains or weather patterns) and children write or draw everything they can remember about that topic.



Think, pair, share to formatively assess understanding and knowledge of geographical vocabulary, locations or processes throughout lesson.
